Supporting Watershed Reporting and Learning in the Upper Thames Watershed

Since 2001, the [Upper Thames River Conservation Authority](#) has published environmental report cards for each of the 28 subwatersheds of the upper Thames Riverwatershed. The report cards present useful and relevant data on the environmental health of each of the subwatersheds in a user friendly manner and grades several environmental factors in the categories of forest conditions and surface water quality. TD Friends of the Foundation supports local students to develop their own report cards; and for teachers and students to participate in field study programs where they learn hands-on environmental monitoring and assessment techniques.
