



# 2022 Conservation Areas Workshop

## Bursary Application

**Free, full event registration will be offered through a merit-based application process.**

The 2022 bursary will aim to achieve the following:

- Encourage participation by Authorities with limited staff and budgets; and
- Encourage attendance by new Conservation Authority team members.

Applicants must hold a full-time position, whether contract or permanent. Conservation Authorities are invited to submit multiple applications; however, preference will be afforded to applicants who are less than 5 years in their current position.

Travel expenses will not be covered by the CAW.

Requirements:

**Applicants should submit the following supporting documents to [caworkshop@cvc.ca](mailto:caworkshop@cvc.ca) by September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022, for consideration.**

1. A letter of request outlining the following:
  - a. Current position and tenure at the Authority
  - b. Related past employment
  - c. How they will benefit from attendance at the Workshop
2. Letter of recommendation from their Supervisor

*Upon review of all applications by the Conservation Areas Workshop Committee, successful applicants will be notified on September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022.*
