What you need to include in your Flood Message



Required Info

- 1. Message Type
- 2. Geographical extent covered by the message
- 3. Issue date
- 4. Message number
- 5. Related active messages and their expiry date
- 6. Identification and contact information of sender (agency and duty officer)
- 7. Flood potential (based on the assessment)
- 8. Reported flooding
- 9. Weather outlook: short and long range
- 10. Watershed conditions (including snow and river conditions)
- 11. Risk of flooding
- 12. Date of expected update
- 13. Expiry date and time
- 14. Request for verification of receipt of message (if applicable)
- 15. Recipient list (if applicable)
