

Conservation Authorities Workshop Bursary

Free registrations will be offered through a merit-based application process. Costs to the participating Authority will be travel and time away from work.

The bursary aims to:

- 1) Encourage participation by Authorities with limited staff and budgets; and
- 2) Encourage attendance by new Conservation Authority team members.
 - Multiple applications are invited from any Conservation Authority
 - Applicants must hold a full-time position (contract or permanent)
 - Preference provided to applicants in current position for less than 5 years
 - Preference provided to applicants who submit an entry to the Innovation Award

Applicants should send a letter with a supporting statement of merit to workshops@rvca.ca by October 1st.

 - Current position and responsibilities
 - Number of years at the Authority
 - Past employment experience
 - How they will benefit from attendance at the Workshop
