

"to provide, in the area over which it has jurisdiction, programs and services designed to further the conservation, restoration, development and management of natural resources"








# Watershed Management Activities Support Mandatory Programs

Watershed Monitoring | Data Collection & Modeling | Watershed Studies, Plans, Assessments & Strategies | Watershed Actions: Stewardship, Green Infrastructure, Outreach, Education & Communication





#### Shared Challenge

- Changing climate
  - More flooding and higher costs (property damages, social stress, business disruptions)
  - ➤ Threatened water quality & supply
  - > Low water levels
  - Stressed or degraded biodiversity

### Towards a Solution



- Watershed wide monitoring, data collecting & modelling
- Watershed studies, plans assessments & strategies
- Watershed wide actions such as stewardship, green infrastructure, outreach, education & communications





### **Shared Challenge**

- More Complex Issues / Fewer Resources
  - ➤ Natural disasters, public health issues impacting budgets





- Multi-stakeholder collaborations
  - (Province, municipalities, CAs, landowners, agencies)
  - Share watershed knowledge and expertise
  - Science-based decision-making
  - Leverage funding and delivery mechanisms
  - Use cost effective watershed-based approach
  - > Provincial guidelines, technical updates, watershed-based policy, funding



#### **Shared Challenge**

- Guiding Development
  - Need to ensure public health and safety
  - Need to increase watershed resiliency
  - Need to support sustainable economic growth & desirable communities



#### **Towards a Solution**

- Improved accountability, transparency and timelines
  - ➤ Conservation Ontario's Client Service and Streamlining Initiative
  - > Provincial policy leadership and consultation with practitioners



- CO Client Service and Streamlining Initiative:
  - Improves client service and accountability
  - Speeds up approvals
  - Reduces red tape and regulatory burden
- Provincial policy leadership and consultation with practitioners
